5	Storyline, script, central theme of the film focuses on current cultural, sociological, political themes in Icelandic or European society. Evaluation notes:	0-2 points
6	Film reflects important Icelandic or European value(s), such as cultural diversity, solidarity, equality, protection of minorities or human rights, tolerance, environmental protection, respect for cultural or family traditions, respect for nature and sustainable use of natural resources. Evaluation notes:	0-2 points
7	Film focuses on Icelandic or European culture, identity or Icelandic or European customs and traditions Evaluation notes:	0-2 points
8	Storyline, script, central theme of the film is based on current or historical events affecting Icelandic or European society. Evaluation notes:	0-2 points

The points for categories 14-16shall be awarded based on to what extent the production fulfils each criterion. The Committee evaluates to what extent the shooting/service provision/post-production takes place in Iceland and adds to the permanent pool of skills and experience in the industry.

The Project must score a minimum of 4 points from the Cultural Criteria, and receive a minimum of 23 points overall, out of a possible total of 46 points.

All point allocations shall be reviewed by the committee appointed in accordance with Art. 3 in Act no. 43/1999.
